Location 01

Scenario: Heavy Rain, Landslide, Road Block, Chardham Tourist Stranded

Location – Netala land slide point, Gangotri NH **30.742643 (N), 78.492410 (E)**

A large group of chardham tourists are traveling to and from Gangotri Dham. Suddenly, heavy rain starts pouring down and causes a landslide that blocks the only road leading to their Gangotri Dham. The tourists cannot move forward or backward due to the roadblock, and the tourists are stranded on the both side of Gangotri NH. Tourists have no access to food, water, or shelter. 2 tourist vehicles are trapped under the debris. 4 persons are seriously injured. 6 persons are injured.

Objectives:

1. Immediate search & Rescue of missing tourist.
2. Provide medical assistance to the injured tourist and shift to nearest health facility.
3. Ensure the safety and well-being of the stranded tourists
4. Provide food, water, and shelter to the tourists
5. Establish communication with the local authorities and provide regular updates on the situation
6. Evacuate the stranded tourists once the roadblock is cleared and it is safe to do so

Actions:

1. Activate IRS and Activate Staging area.
2. Assess the situation and determine the number of tourists and their condition
3. Provide food, water, and blankets to the tourists to keep them hydrated and warm
4. Check the bus for any damages and ensure it is safe for the tourists to stay in
5. Use the available resources to establish a temporary shelter for the tourists, such as using the bus as a shelter or setting up tents
6. Assign staff members to communicate regularly with the local authorities and provide them with updates on the situation, including the number of tourists, their condition, and any urgent needs
7. Coordinate with local authorities to ensure that the necessary resources, such as food, water, and medical supplies, are available to the stranded tourists
8. Develop a plan for evacuating the stranded tourists once the roadblock is cleared and it is safe to do so, and communicate the plan to the tourists and the local authorities
9. Keep the tourists informed and reassured about the progress of the evacuation and the estimated timeline for its completion

Scenario: Fire in a Hotel/Dharamshala

Location- Birla Dharamshala, Bus stand, Uttarkashi **30.729658 (N), 78.437716 (E)**

A fire has broken out in a Birla Dharamshala, and the guests are currently unaware of the situation. The fire started in the Dharamshala kitchen, and has spread to the adjacent areas. The Birla Dharamshala is a 2-story building with approximately 100 guests and staff members.

Objectives:

1. Ensure the safety of all guests and staff members
2. Evacuate the building and direct guests to the designated assembly area
3. Isolate the fire and prevent it from spreading to other areas of the hotel
4. Provide first aid and medical assistance to any injured guests or staff members
5. Communicate effectively with emergency responders and provide them with necessary information

Actions:

1. Activate the IRS and call the fire department immediately
2. Evacuate the building floor by floor, directing guests to the designated assembly area
3. Assign staff members to help evacuate guests who need assistance, such as those with disabilities or children
4. Instruct guests to leave all their belongings.
5. Use fire extinguishers to try to contain the fire if it is safe to do so and if the fire is small enough
6. Isolate the fire by closing any doors and windows in the affected areas
7. Provide first aid and medical assistance to any injured guests or staff members
8. Communicate regularly with emergency responders and provide them with updates on the situation

Scenario: Road Accident/ Drowning

Location : Dharasu Band, **30.645369 (N), 78.328398 (E)**

01. A serious road accident has occurred on a Gangotri NH near Dharasu Band, involving multiple vehicles and several injured people. Teams has been called in to assist in the rescue and relief efforts.
02. A bus carrying chardham yatri has fallen into a Bhagirathi River. There are people inside the bus who are trapped and need immediate assistance.

Objectives:

1. Ensure the safety and well-being of the injured people
2. Provide medical assistance to the injured people
3. Coordinate with control room and emergency responders to clear the accident scene
4. Ensure that traffic is diverted and the area is safe for rescue and relief operations
5. Evacuate the injured people to nearby hospitals or medical canters
6. Provide necessary resources, such as food, water, and shelter, to the affected people

Actions:

1. Assess the situation and determine the number of injured people and their condition
2. Assign staff members to coordinate with local authorities and emergency responders and provide them with regular updates on the situation
3. Provide medical assistance to the injured people and stabilize their condition
4. Coordinate with local authorities and emergency responders to clear the accident scene as soon as possible and ensure that the area is safe for rescue and relief operations
5. Ensure that traffic is diverted and the area is safe for rescue and relief operations
6. Evacuate the injured people to nearby hospitals or medical centres by providing them with transportation or coordinating with local authorities to arrange for transportation
7. Establish temporary shelters for the affected people and provide necessary resources, such as food, water, blankets, and medical assistance
8. Communicate regularly with the affected people and their families and keep them informed about the progress of the rescue and relief efforts

Scenario: Cloud Burst, Flash Flood/Forest Fire

Location – Kharadi Village, **30.847767 (N), 78.281743 (E)**

A small town Kharadi on Yamunotri NH is hit by a cloud burst that causes a flash flood. The floodwaters rise quickly, and many residents are trapped in their homes or stranded on the streets. The local authorities have activated the IRS, and your team has been called in to assist in the rescue and relief efforts.

Objectives:

2. Ensure the safety and well-being of the affected residents
3. Rescue and evacuate the residents who are trapped or stranded
4. Provide food, water, and medical assistance to the affected residents
5. Coordinate with local authorities to establish temporary shelters and provide necessary resources
6. Assess the damage caused by the flood and initiate the cleanup and recovery process

Actions:

1. Assess the situation and determine the number of affected residents and their condition
2. Identify the areas that are most affected by the flood and prioritize the rescue and evacuation efforts accordingly
3. Assign staff members to coordinate with local authorities and emergency responders and provide them with regular updates on the situation
4. Use boats or any other available resources to rescue the residents who are trapped in their homes or stranded on the streets
5. Provide food, water, and medical assistance to the affected residents and ensure that they are safe and comfortable
6. Coordinate with local authorities to establish temporary shelters for the affected residents and provide necessary resources, such as food, water, and blankets
7. Assess the damage caused by the flood and initiate the cleanup and recovery process, such as removing debris and repairing damaged infrastructure
8. Communicate regularly with the affected residents and keep them informed about the progress of the rescue, relief, and recovery efforts

Location 05

Scenario: A large crowd of Chardham yatri has gathered at Jankichatti, the crowd has grown larger than anticipated. The protesters have begun to clash with the authorities.

Location : Jankichatti, **30.974445 (N), 78.436252 (E)**

1. Assess the situation: First, the officials need to assess the situation and determine the best course of action. They should identify any potential safety hazards, such as broken glass or debris, and plan a safe exit route for the crowd.
2. Issue a dispersal order: The officials should issue a clear and concise dispersal order, using loudspeakers or megaphones if necessary. They should provide clear instructions on where the crowd should go and how to disperse safely.

Scenario: Forest Fire Outbreak in tehsil Purola

Location : Chandeli, Purola 30.858744 (N), 78.085652 (E)

Background: A forest fire has broken out in a densely forested area. The fire is spreading rapidly, and there is a risk that it could reach nearby communities. Forest team has been called in to respond to the situation and prevent further damage.

Task: Your team is responsible for developing a plan to contain the forest fire, protect nearby communities, and minimize the damage caused by the fire.

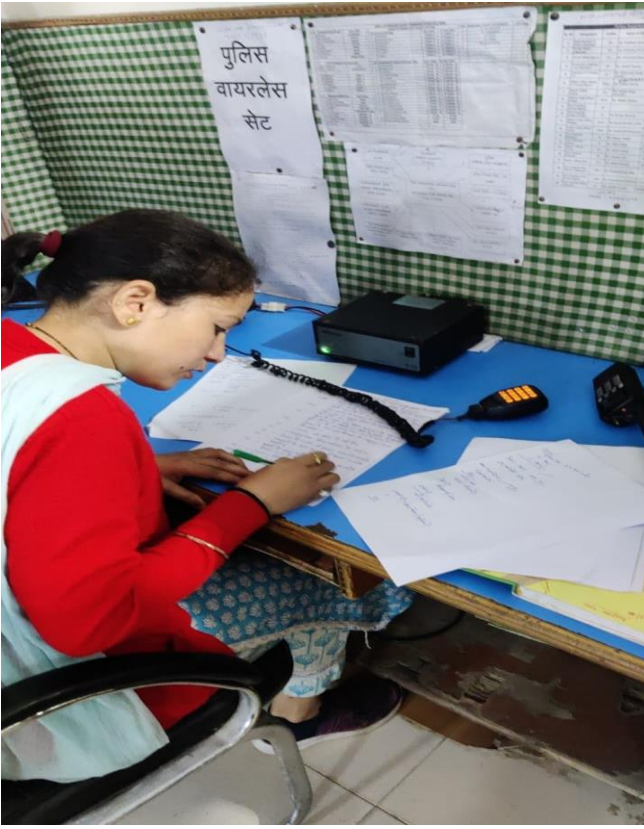

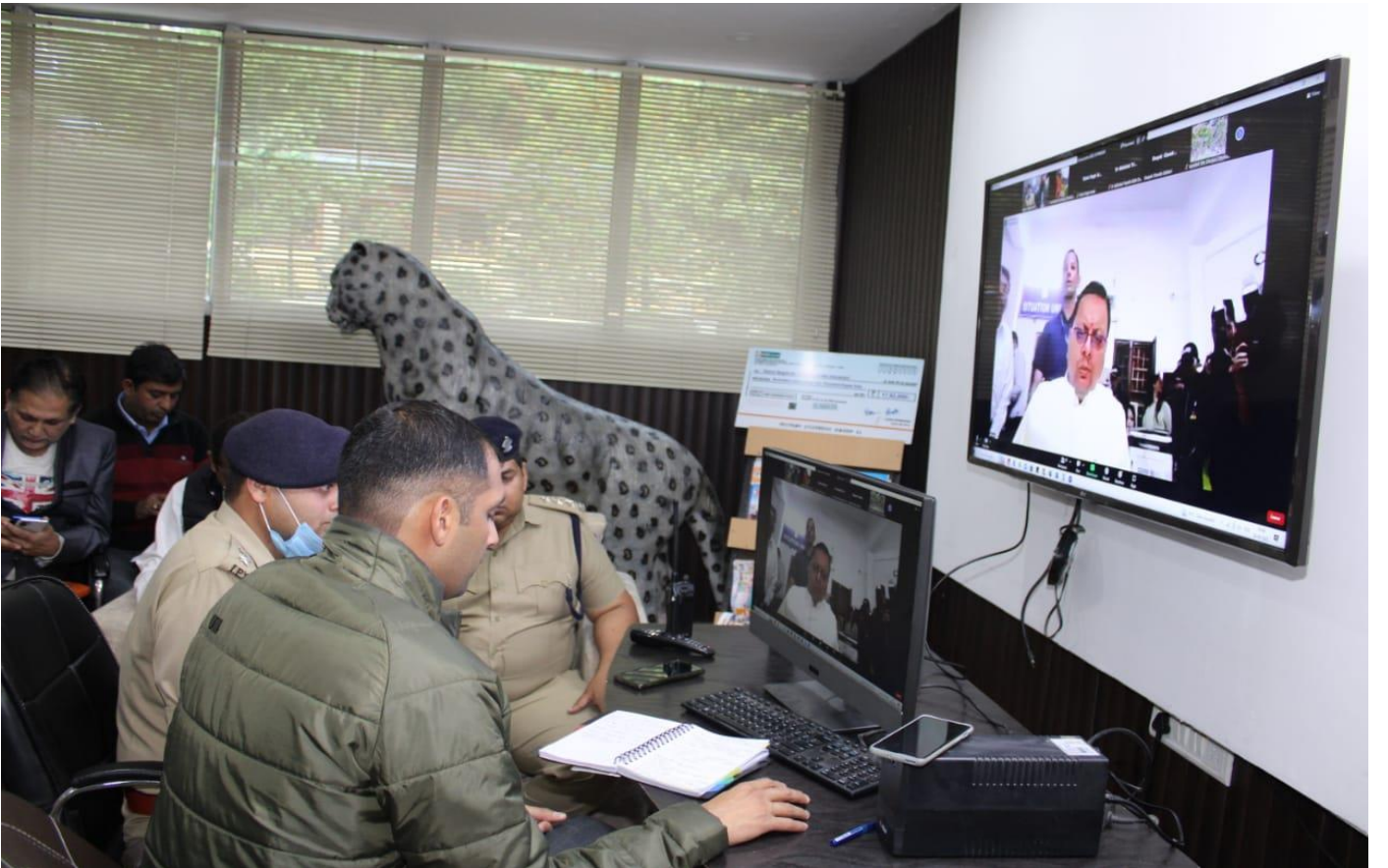

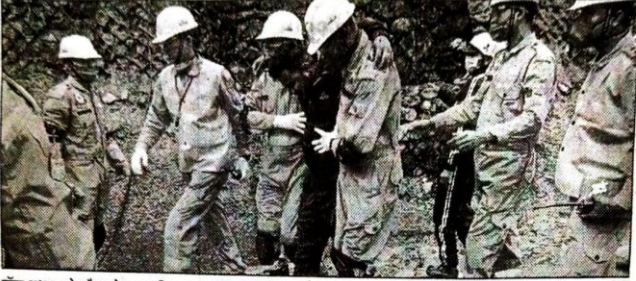
